Regulatory change reaches the responsible owner

Core capabilities

The main activities and the information they connect.

Regulator horizon scanning

Filter change signals by jurisdiction and entity.

Consultation deadlines

Keep consultation windows and responses visible.

Obligation mapping

Relate proposed obligations to controls and policies.

Draft filings and call reports

Prepare submissions for specialist review.

From daily work to oversight

Supporting functions keep decisions and evidence current.

Regulatory knowledge graph

Connect obligations with responsible owners.

Versioned obligation library

Retain obligation changes and effective dates.

Change impact assessment

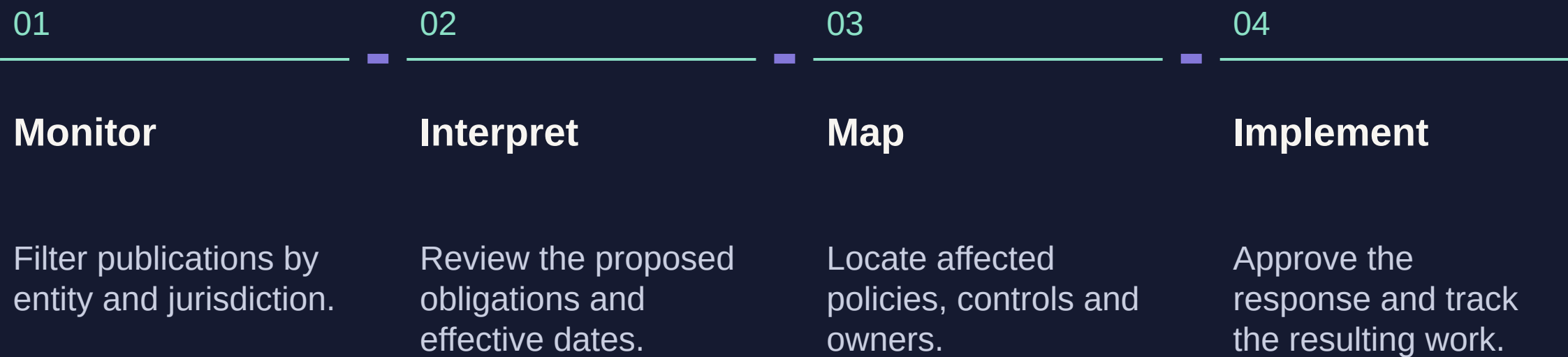
Identify affected records and route the review.

Jurisdiction and framework packs

Use relevant requirement mappings as a starting point.

How the work moves

A proposed operating workflow for your evaluation.



A publication becomes a tracked obligation

The relationships that make the workflow understandable.

01

Publication

The original text and version.

02

Applicability

The legal entity and activity affected.

03

Impact

The policy or control that needs attention.

04

Action

An owner, due date and completion evidence.

A rule changes a reporting obligation

A new publication appears relevant to a business unit, with a future effective date and a consultation window.

Team response

A specialist confirms applicability, checks the proposed control mapping, and assigns policy updates and response deadlines.

Decision point

Interpretation and any submission require the designated reviewer.

What changes for your team

The practical value to evaluate against your current process.

A shorter route to impact review

Filtered changes and proposed mappings help specialists begin with the affected records.

More visible accountability

Named owners and effective dates show which changes still need interpretation or implementation.

Where this module connects

Confirm the interfaces and available data for the intended deployment.

Sources	Regulator publications, entity profiles and internal policies.
Connected modules	Compliance, Enterprise GRC and Financial Risk.
Working outputs	Impact assessments, obligation versions and reviewed drafts.

What to validate in your evaluation

Use a representative case and agree the acceptance evidence before expansion.

Regulatory specialist

Confirm applicability and approve interpretations.

Evidence

Retain the source version, mapping rationale and response.

Measure

Track time to assessment and unassigned changes near deadlines.

Bring a representative workflow, its source records and the people who own the decision.

Starting point
